## Study Link Help: Remainders

When a division problem has a remainder, the two sides of the number model are not exactly equal. For this reason, Everyday Mathematics uses an arrow in number models for division with remainders.

## Help with Study Link Problems

$102 \div 50->2 \mathrm{R} 2$
Using the equals sign when writing this type of number model may cause confusion about the meaning of the equal sign.

## Example:

$102 \div 50=4.04$
$102 \div 50 \neq 2 \mathrm{R} 2$
2 R 2 is not a number.
Using the arrow helps eliminate the confusion
